Dear Parents/Carers

The Temporary Governing Body for the new amalgamated school is delighted to announce that Hampshire County Council Children's Services has earmarked a substantial amount of money to be spent on building work to the current Yateley Infant School site. This will give us a Primary school in Yateley which has been built for the 21st century.

To enable this building work on the Yateley Infant School site to be carried out as quickly and as safely as possible with the least disruption to pupils education the new Primary school will be situated, for one year only, on the current St Peter's C of E Junior School site from September 2010 until the end of the summer term 2011. Remedial work to the current St Peters school site will take place during the summer of 2010 to provide a school with facilities which are suitable for all children. The improved St Peter's site will have all the facilities, resources and security needed to deliver a good education for the whole age range of children at a Primary school.

The construction on the Yateley Infant site will be completed by September 2011, ready for a grand opening.

We are also pleased to be able to confirm that Yateley Community Pre-school, currently located on the Yateley Infant site, will not be affected by the building work and safe access to it will be maintained during the construction work.

Hampshire County Council Children's Services and the Temporary Governing Body are working together to plan the best possible school building, and a planning application will be made early in 2010.
