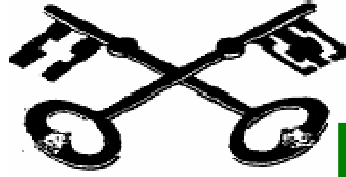

### Learning opportunities for Senior Citizens

Silver Surfers Computer for Beginners is free and runs on 21<sup>st</sup> May 10.00-12.00 and 12.30-2.30 at Yateley Library.

### Introduction to Falconry- Adult Learning

The course will run for 5 weeks on a Wednesday starting 24th Feb 19:00-21:00

Week One - Introduction to the birds, species and terminology/Obtaining a bird, and law surrounding it

Week Two - Equipment, Housing and learning the (essential) falconers knot

Week Three - Nutrition/Anatomy & Physiology/Moulting

Week Four - Training/Rearing Methods

Week Five - Healthcare/Disease Prevention.

See differing species of birds, varying between owls, falcons and hawks.

This course will include an appropriate amount of handling and equip students with knowledge to handle and care for birds of prey, and also practice the sport and art of falconry, with competence

The course also includes an outdoor session flying Birds of Prey and cost £92.00
