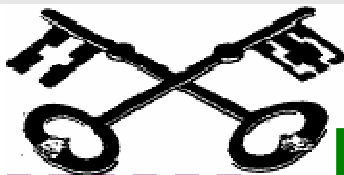

This week our National School Grounds' Week activities have included children designing a Sculpture in the style of the artist, Goldsworthy, planning and making a model of a 3D animal or insect, researching and writing amazing animal fact files. Year 6 have been 'estate agents' marketing animal habitats for sale. All the children have participated in an Inter-House Competition which was a Photographic Quiz featuring some unusual photos of our school grounds. Staff and children have been enthralled watching the BBC Spring Watch web cams recording the progress of the baby Kestrels and Swallows - When will they fledge? It's an amazing sight and I thoroughly recommend the programme...

The children had a very enjoyable morning at the Science Fair - learning how to keep themselves safe at home from the Hampshire Fire and Rescue Service. They even made circuits for a large scale working fire alarm. The Robot workshop provided children with the opportunity to develop their computer programming skills so that the robot moved along a predefined route. Children also had a hands-on experience with the Mill Cottage Farm workshop exploring cheese and butter making. 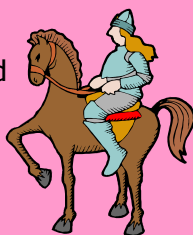

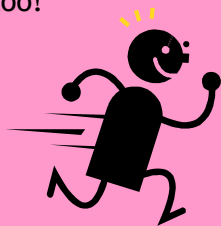
