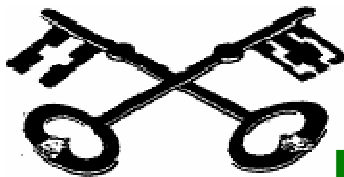

Home Access Opportunities

Home Access is a government initiative that helps low-income families who currently have no access to a computer nor internet to get online at home.

This fund is still available for parents/carers to apply. This funding should be available until February 2011 but this programme will close down when the money runs out and this can be anytime – please check it out at www.homeaccess.org.uk

The programme is aimed at those who need it most. Parents/carers who are low-income families and in receipt of certain benefits could qualify for a grant to buy a computer together with possible funding for a minimum of one year's internet access.



Child Safety near Power Lines and Substations Power Lines and Substations are a necessary part of the community and the countryside, essential to transport energy to our homes and businesses. They are perfectly safe when left alone.

However, if children and adults don't take care when near power lines and substations, then they could find themselves in dangerous situations like these:

- A fishing rod carried the wrong way can touch a power line
- Trying to retrieve a football from a substation
- Flying kites near power lines

Scottish and Southern Energy power distribution have a web site which has an area specifically designed for 7-11 year olds.

You can find it at www.scottish-southern.co.uk and select Corporate Responsibility then Education. For the younger children the item is called "cool stuff" and the topics included basic electrical safety, energy efficiency, science and history facts about Scottish and Southern Energy.
